



## Exeter Seaforth Return to Play Policies

### Seaforth Arena

Allowed in 15 minutes prior to the ice time – must meet COVID team leader at door before entry. Each team must provide their own COVID team leader to check in their people.

Contact Tracing sheet must be completed by both teams – copies sent to [president@c4thstorm.ca](mailto:president@c4thstorm.ca)

Maximum 30 people allowed on ice – includes players, coaches, officials and timekeeper

Each team is allowed 14 people in total – includes players and bench staff.

Dressing rooms – 10 people allowed, chairs outside for tying skates

50 people allowed in the stands – only one spectator per player. Each team is allowed 24.

Exit the arena through the door that leads out by the hall, not the main entrance. Teams must exit 15 minutes after their ice time.

Face coverings must be worn by everyone in facility. Players may take off their masks when they put their helmets on.

### Hensall Arena

Allowed in 15 minutes prior to the ice time – must meet COVID team leader at door before entry. Each team must provide their own COVID team leader to check in their people.

Contact Tracing sheet must be completed by both teams – copies sent to [president@c4thstorm.ca](mailto:president@c4thstorm.ca)

Dressing rooms – 12 people allowed, chairs outside for tying skates

Total people allowed within the ice surface and spectator area is 50 – includes players, coaches, officials, timekeepers and spectators. Home team will provide one person to do time clock/score sheet.

Each team is allowed a total of 23 people – includes players, bench staff and spectators. One spectator per player maximum.

Face coverings must be worn by everyone while in facility. Players may take off their masks when they put their helmet on.

There is a separate exit door, follow the signs to exit.
